


Crown Roach


All of the detail of making porky roaches can be found in our book, "The Making of a Porky Roach". These instructions for making the smaller crown roach are the changes in measurements needed for this project.

Porky hair needed is about $1\frac{1}{4}$ ounce, about half of which is 6 to 6 1/2 inch in length and the rest 4 to 6 inches. Clean and then sort this hair into the following groups: $4^{"}$, $4^{"}$, $5^{"}$, $5^{"}$, $6^{"}$, $6^{"}$, $6^{"}$.


Inside row of deer hair:




Porky row - full length:

Two 4 foot long braids should be made as described beginning on page 9 in the book. They are braided and sewn in the same way as described in the book, but the shape is to be like a tear drop with a dimension of 8 inches from front to back and $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches in width at the braid hole.
